Located at the northwest corner of Mill and Trench Streets (two stop signs north of York Central Hospital), the concerts will take place at the Park Gazebo. **Please note that limited parking is available adjacent to the Park. Concerts' parking is available at the York Central Hospital East Parking Lot on Thursday nights after 5:30 p.m. courtesy of York Central Hospital.**



Located at 1300 Elgin Mills Road East (northwest corner of Elgin Mills Road East and Leslie Street), the concerts will take place at the Amphitheatre north of the Sports Complex building. To access the closest event parking, drive north on Leslie Street to William F. Bell Parkway, where parking is available north of the Amphitheatre.
