Planned Work

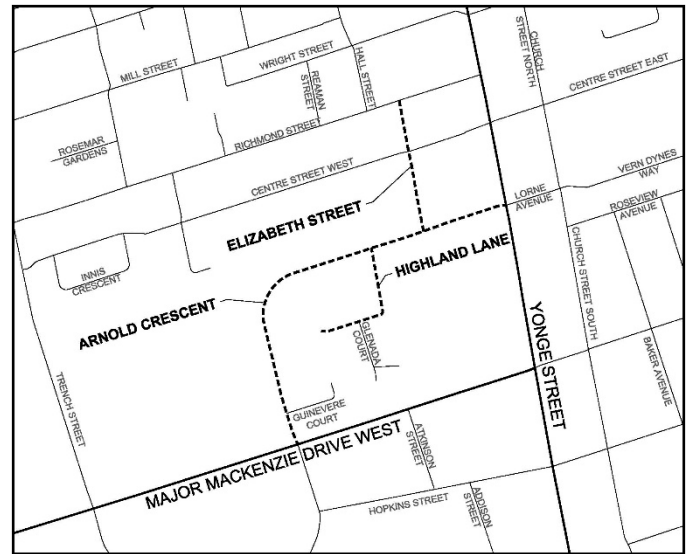
As part of the City of Richmond Hill's ongoing commitment to maintaining a high quality road network, the City will be undertaking the detailed design for the reconstruction of Arnold Crescent, Highland Lane and Elizabeth Street pending budget approval. The scope of work may include reconstruction of the road to urban standards with new asphalt pavement, curbs, gutters, sidewalk and storm sewers, watermain replacement, and streetlight improvements.

Impacted on Local Residents

City staff and consultants will be in your area over the year to undertake preliminary investigations. In order to complete the topographic survey and other data collection, City representatives will need to briefly enter upon your property to locate existing features and collect elevations beyond the municipal road allowance. This action is necessary to ensure that all ground surface details are accurately identified for the design.
