

Arnold Crescent, Highland Lane and Elizabeth Street Road Reconstruction

Planned Road Closure

Please be advised that **Elizabeth Street, between Arnold Crescent and Richmond Street**, will be closed to through traffic **starting August 5, 2026, until the end of August 2026** (see map). This closure is required to safely complete major watermain infrastructure upgrades.

Due to extensive excavation and construction activities, road closure is necessary to protect public safety and allow the work to be completed efficiently.

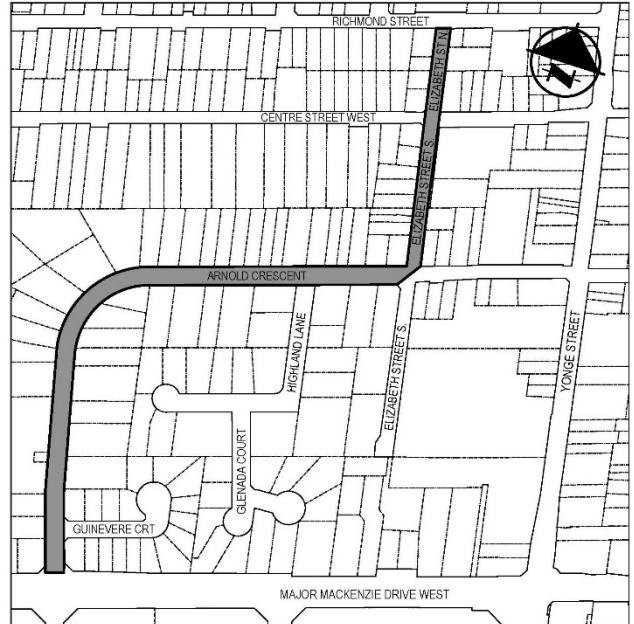
Please note that **Arnold Crescent, between Major Mackenzie Drive and Elizabeth Street, remains closed**. Motorists are recommended to use Yonge Street or Major Mackenzie Drive as alternate routes.

Traffic and Resident Impacts

- **Emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times.**
- **Local access will be permitted for residents within the closure limits.**
- All other traffic will be detoured using Trench Street, Major Mackenzie Drive and Yonge Street.

Residents and motorists should expect changes to travel routes and possible delays during construction. The City is working closely with its contractor to minimize disruption and complete the work as safely and efficiently as possible.
