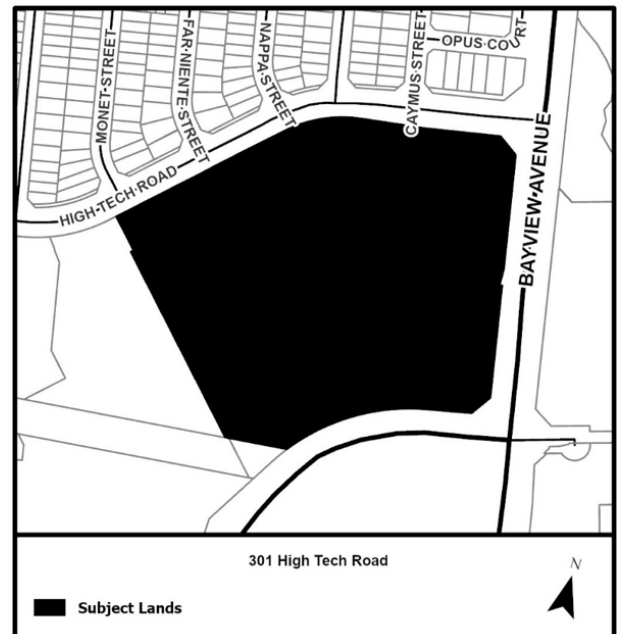


NOTICE OF COMPLETE APPLICATION

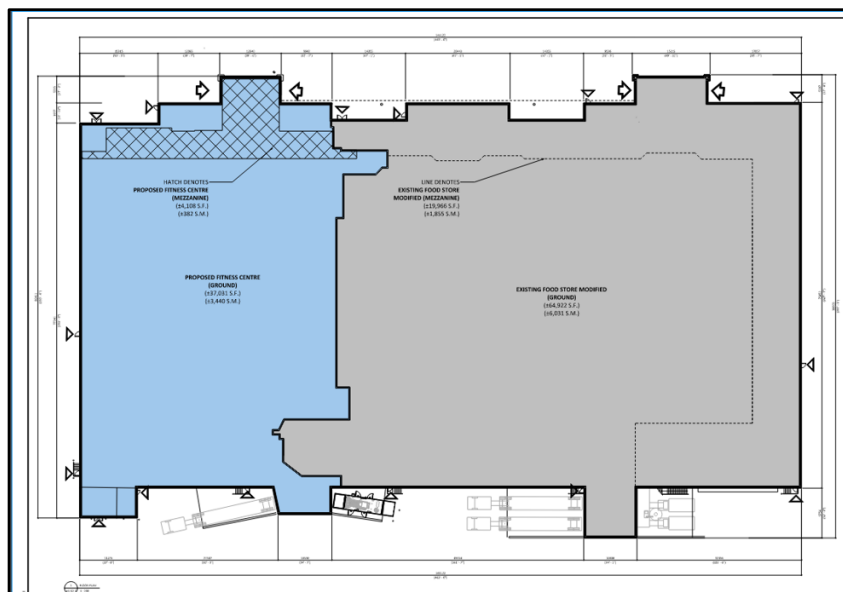
