The membership of the Committee will be comprised as follows:

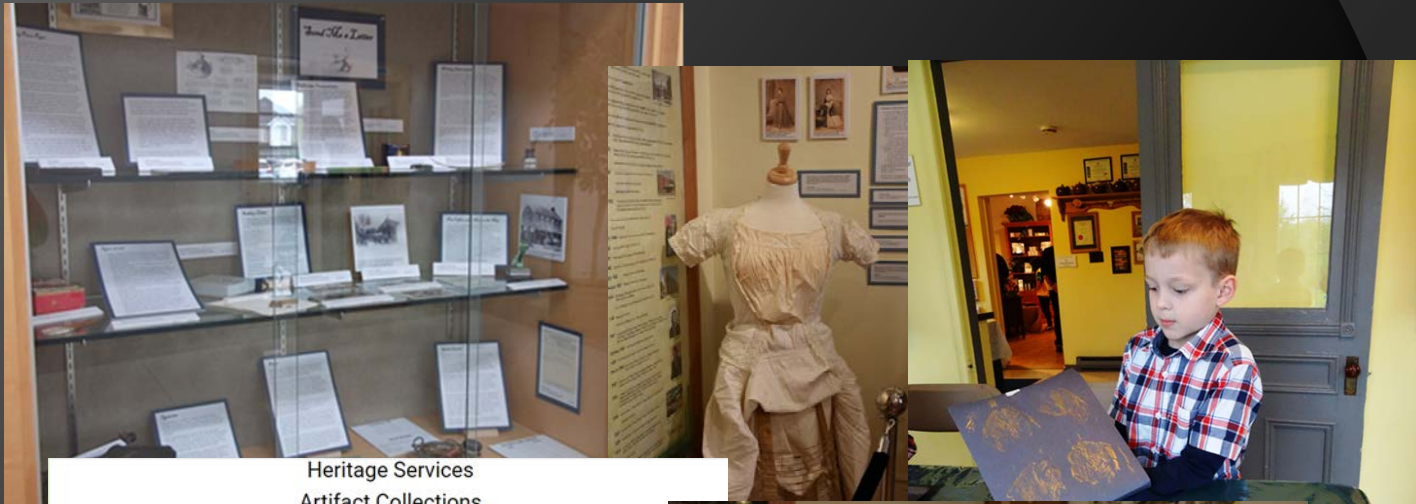
- the Mayor;
