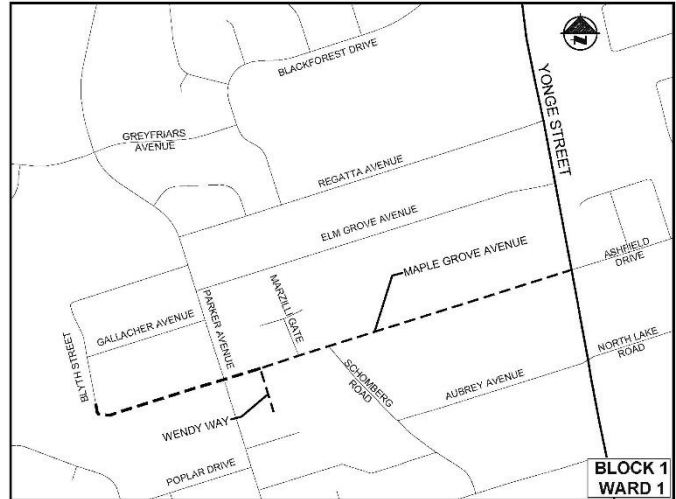


Maple Grove Avenue and Wendy Way Road Reconstruction

Dear Residents,
Please be advised that the City of Richmond Hill will be undertaking road reconstruction works on Maple Grove Avenue and Wendy Way. This notice provides information on the project scope, schedule, anticipated impacts, and City contact information.

Upcoming Key Schedule

- Mid-March 2026: Construction start
- Late 2026: Substantial completion of underground works
- Summer 2027: Substantial completion of surface road works



Construction schedules are subject to change due to weather or site conditions. Residents will be notified of any significant changes as work progresses.

What's Happening?

The contractor will carry out road excavation, removal of existing ditches and culverts, asphalt paving, installation of curbs and gutters, driveway regrading, sidewalk construction, and upgrades to storm sewers, catch basins, watermains, and street lighting as part of the road reconstruction.

What to Expect:

During construction, roads will generally remain accessible to local vehicular traffic only. Temporary traffic diversions and restricted driveway access may be required at certain times to safely accommodate construction activities.

Occasionally, a full road closure may be necessary for safety or operational reasons. Should this occur, advance notice will be provided, and detour signage will be installed to guide motorists.

Scheduled water service disruptions will be required to complete the watermain work. Advance notice will be provided prior to any service interruptions.

Reminders:

- As part of the road reconstruction, the existing roadside ditches will be filled in. All private buried drainpipes (e.g. sump pump or roof drains) that currently discharge into the existing ditches within the City's property or boulevard must be disconnected and modified to discharge onto the lawn and drain overland within the private property by the homeowner prior to the road reconstruction. Please refer to Attachment 1 for further details on the sump pump outlet.
- Private gardens and underground systems (e.g. heated driveways) located within the City's property or boulevard may be impacted by the proposed construction work. The City will not be responsible for any damage to the privately-owned items that are within the City's property.

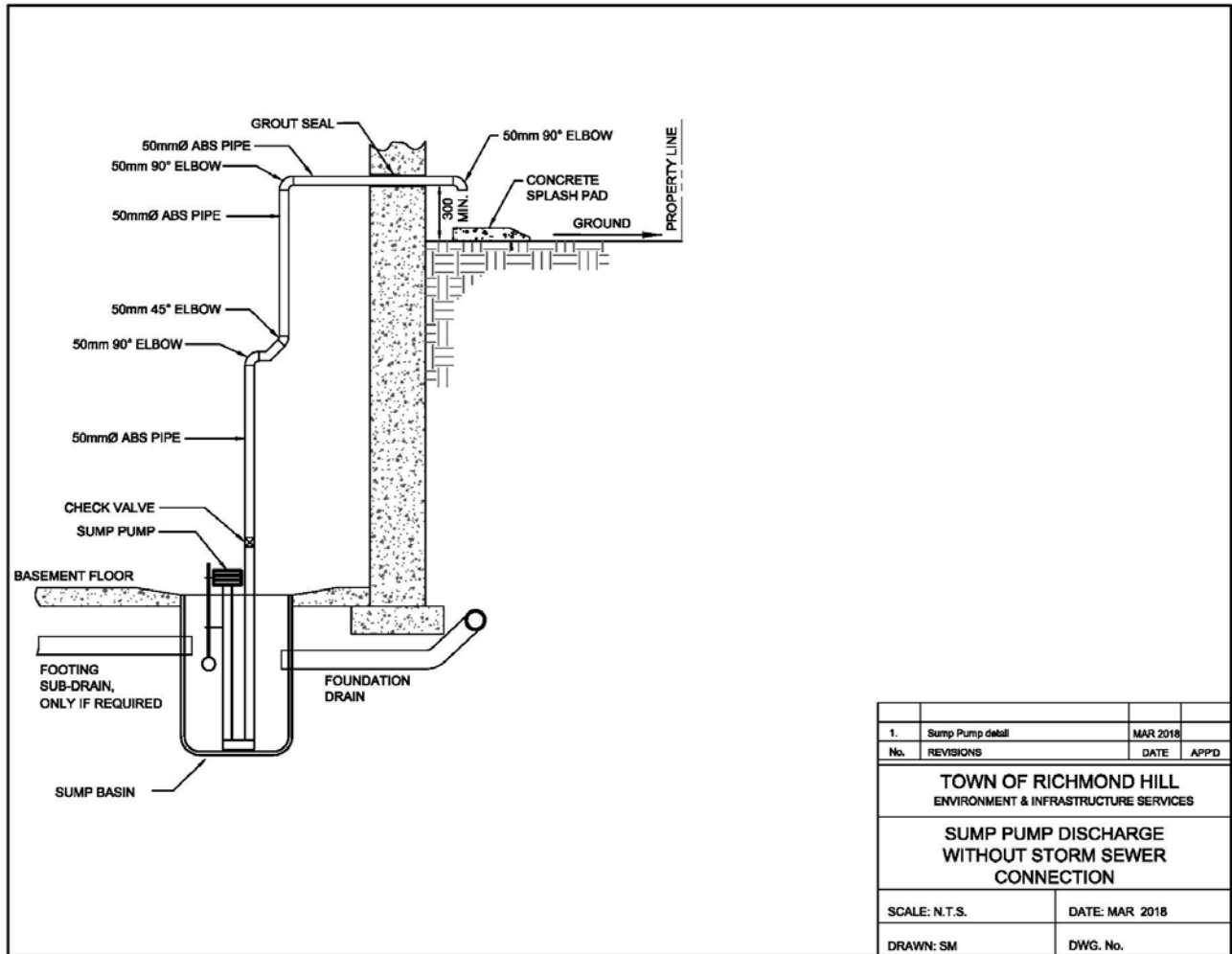


Figure 1 – Sump Pump Discharge to the Ground Surface
