

Valleymede Drive Southbound Right Turn Lane at Highway 7

The City of Richmond Hill is installing a new southbound right turn lane on Valleymede Drive to Highway 7 and intersection improvements to enhance traffic operations and improve safety for all road users.

Construction Schedule:

Construction is anticipated to begin in April 2026 and is expected to be completed by Summer 2026, weather permitting.

What's Happening?

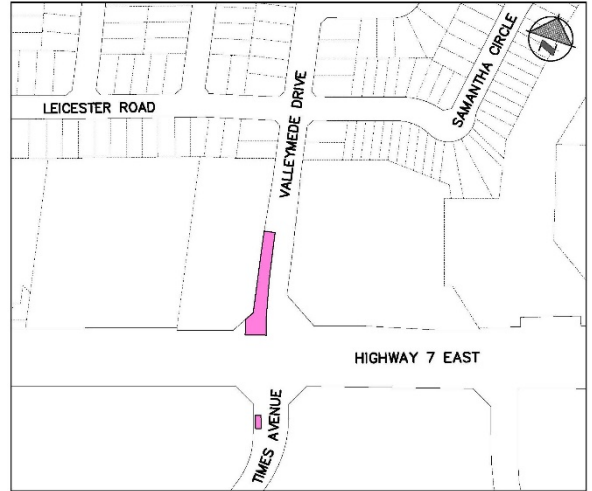
The scope of work includes removal of existing infrastructure, utilities relocation, installation of new pavement, replacement of curb and gutter, replacement of sidewalk, and restoration of all disturbed areas.

What to Expect:

During the construction, partial lane closures and traffic delays will occur. Temporary traffic diversions may be necessary at certain times to facilitate construction activities safely and efficiently. Please exercise caution when travelling through the construction area and follow the directions of all traffic control personnel and signage. We appreciate your patience and cooperation as we complete these infrastructure improvements.

Transit Impact:

The York Region Transit (YRT) bus stop will be permanently relocated from Valleymede Drive, north of Highway 7, to Times Avenue, south of Highway 7. Please contact YRT directly regarding bus stops and bus services.
