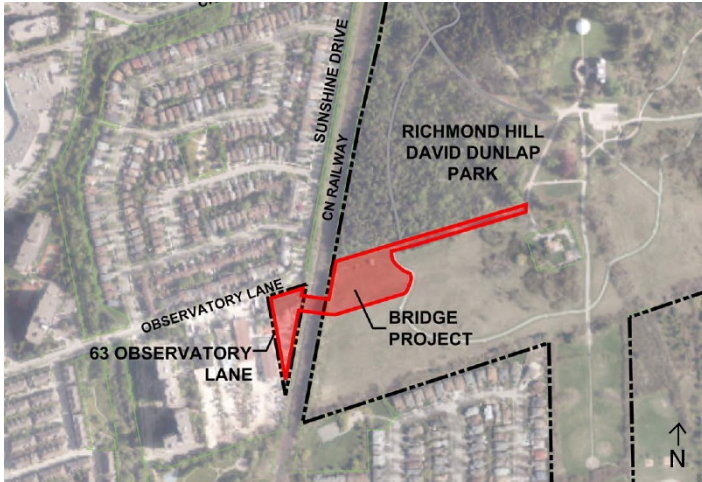


DDO Pedestrian and Cyclist Bridge



Planned Construction Work

We are constructing a new pedestrian and cyclist bridge over the CN Rail Corridor to provide a safe pedestrian connection between David Dunlap Observatory Park and 63 Observatory Lane. The project includes the construction of the new bridge, parking lot with 14 spaces, entry plaza, trails, pedestrian lighting, site furnishings, and tree planting.

Construction is scheduled to begin shortly and be completed by end of 2025, weather permitting. As a measure of safety, a portion of the David Dunlap Observatory Park will be closed and residents are asked to refrain from entering the construction area. The Observatory and Administration building and remaining portions of the park will remain open. Thank you in advance for your patience during the construction phase of this project.
