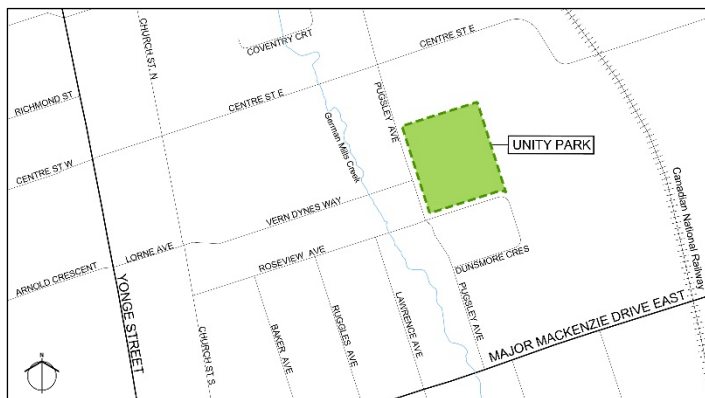


Unity Park Revitalization

Planned Construction Work

The City of Richmond Hill is revitalizing Unity Park. This includes new play equipment, safety surfacing, upgrades to existing walkways, site furniture, signage, pedestrian lighting, planting, and the replacement of the gazebo and shade structures.

Unity Park will also become the home of the *PS752 Memorial*, dedicated to honoring the 176 victims of Flight PS752.

Park construction is scheduled to start in June 2026 and be completed by December 2026, weather permitting. As a measure of safety, the park will be closed during construction and residents are asked to refrain from entering the park.
