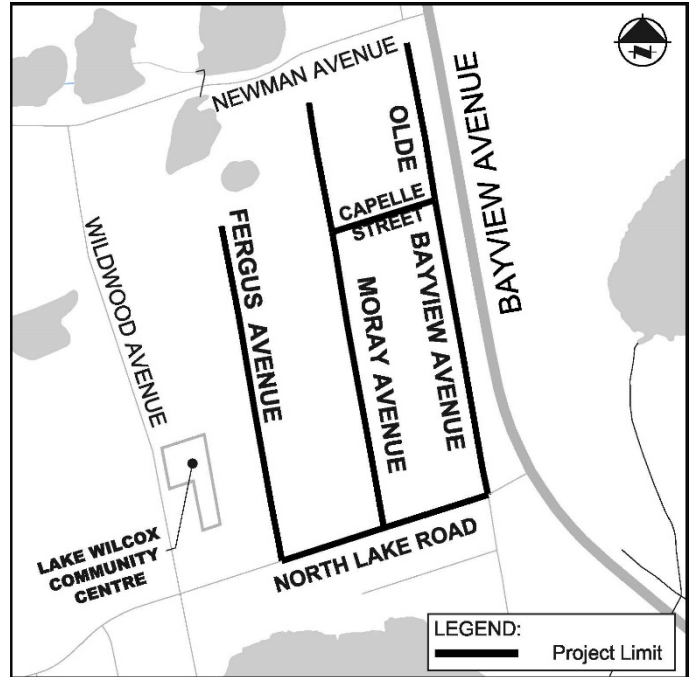


Fergus Avenue, Moray Avenue, Olde Bayview Avenue and Capelle Street Reconstruction

Planned Work

As part of the City of Richmond Hill’s ongoing commitment to maintaining a high quality road network, the City will be commencing the preliminary investigations for reconstruction of Fergus Avenue, Moray Avenue, Olde Bayview Avenue and Capelle Street. The scope of work may include removal of roadside ditches and driveway culverts, new asphalt pavement, new storm sewer, new curb and gutter, new sidewalk, watermain replacement, sanitary upgrades and streetlight improvements. Detailed design is scheduled to commence in 2024, pending Council approval.



Impact on Local Residents

City staff and consultants will be in your area in Summer 2023 to undertake preliminary investigations. In order to complete the topographic survey and other data collection, City representatives will need to briefly enter upon your property to locate existing features and collect elevations beyond the municipal road allowance. This action is necessary to ensure that all ground surface details are accurately identified for the design.
