



Complaint Form and Affidavit - Member of a Local Board

Under Section 223.4(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, as amended, a person may request the Integrity Commissioner to conduct an inquiry as to whether a Member of a Local Board (“Member”) has contravened the Code of Conduct for Council and Local Boards.

Information on filing a Code of Conduct Complaint against a Member of a Local Board:

1. A complaint that a Member has contravened the Code Conduct of Conduct for Council and Local Boards (“Code”) may be filed by any person or entity. A Member is any person, including any Citizen member, appointed by Council to serve on any of the City’s Boards or Committees (see list of Boards and Committees on page 2).
2. A complaint that a Member has contravened the Code must be submitted within six (6) weeks of the complainant becoming aware of the alleged contravention, and no more than six (6) months after the alleged violation, unless otherwise provided in the Code.
3. In accordance with subsection 223.4(9) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, during the Election Period no complaint that a Member has contravened the Code may be submitted by any person. The Election Period means the time period that starts on Nomination day and ends on Voting Day in a regular election year.
4. A complainant is required to provide the following information:
 - a) the name of the Member alleged to have contravened the Code, and the name of the Local Board or Committee to which that Member has been appointed;
 - b) the numbered section(s) of the Code allegedly contravened by the Member;
 - c) the date, time and location of the alleged contravention(s);
 - d) an explanation as to why the complainant believes that the issue raised may be a contravention of the Code;
 - e) any other evidence in support of the allegation must be included and shall be dated and signed by the complainant; and
 - f) the full contact information for the complainant, including mailing address, telephone number, and email address.
5. A complainant is also required to complete an affidavit attesting to the facts that the complainant is alleging. An affidavit must be signed and sworn or affirmed before the City Clerk, a Deputy Clerk, a Notary Public or a Commissioner for taking affidavits.
