Layered planting that mimics the vertical structure of riverbanks, with a mix of low-lying plants, mid-height shrubs, and large canopy trees



The dynamic nature of river systems and their role in shaping landscapes



Curved and meandering pathways that mimic river bends, with varying widths and textures that simulate different river formations

.....Richmond Hill's 'Bird Friendly City' bird



The design aims to integrate the Great Blue Heron, the City of Richmond Hill's 'Bird Friendly City' bird in a symbolic feature at the entrance of the park. The proposed poles indicate the Great Blue Heron as a symbol of the natural heritage features that are found throughout Richmond Hill, and highlight the role of parks and open spaces in raising awareness about the importance of natural habitat conservation.
